**Subject :** Permission of the Central Government to the Perinthalaivar Kamraj Medical College Society, Puducherry to start a new Rajiv Gandhi Ayurveda Medical College and Hospital at Chalakkari Village, Mahe, Puducherry with annual intake capacity of 50 seats in B.A.M.S. course under Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 - reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the Department's letter of even No. dated 13.08.2010 on the subject cited above and to say that after careful consideration of the recommendations of the C.C.I.M. and the compliance submitted by the Principal Secretary (Health), Govt. of Puducherry in terms of the provisions of the IMCC Act and relevant regulations and norms of the CCIM, the permission of the Central Government is hereby accorded to the Perinthalaivar Kamraj Medical College Society, Puducherry to start a new Rajiv Gardhi Ayurveda Medical College and Hospital at Chalakkari Village, Mahe, Puducherry with annual intake capacity of 50 seats in Ayurvedachrya (B.A.M.S.) Course from the academic year 2010-11 under the provisions of section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970.

2. The college administration will ensure that the assurance given by the Principal Secretary (Health), Govt. of Puducherry vide letter No.547/Health/Ayur.Col./2010 dated 20.08.2010 is fulfilled and sufficient infrastructure and qualified teachers and non-teaching

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staff in the college and requisite staff in the hospital, as per the relevant CCIM Regulations and norms, are available before the admission of the first batch of students in the Ist Professional of B.A.M.S. course is made, under intimation to the Central Government and CCIM.

The College has to develop the requisite infrastructure for IInd and IIIrd Professionals well in time as per the C.C.I.M. norms which will be verified and reported by the CCIM at least three months before the start of next Professional and accordingly, the permission for taking admissions in subsequent academic session will be issued.

The College administration may take up the matter for recognition of the qualification under Section 14(2) of the IMCC Act, 1970 at that time when the first batch of students admitted against this course appears for the first final professional examination of the said course.
